OUR ON-GOING PROGRAMS AT THE LEARN! FOUNDATION

Program 1: Learn! Companion

What it is about: Improving teaching, learning, and leading in schools

Focus: Public primary Schools

Ongoing Activities

- Constructing teachers houses so that teachers can stay at the school compound to continue supporting learners in their learning journey and while at the same time, save them on commuting costs.
- Providing seating facilities for parents to use during school meetings so that they don't have to use students' desks, hence disrupting learning.
- Working with partners to enhance and build life skills that support holistic development of the child.
- Provide school uniforms to > 1500 children in 2 schools (Mbwana and Makonjemare) under the Ticket to school project.
- Supporting in repairing project, like fixing the solar system at Makonjemare and repairing the play materials (swings and slides) so that children can play and enjoy their childhood.
- Support school feeding and school garden utilization for better nutrition for all learners, including paying for the gardeners salary and extending the school garden.

Program 2: The Learn! Centre

What is it about: Improving learning and building competencies using ICT as a strategic enabler

Focus: Primary school learners

On-going activities

• Equipping learners with the 21st century skills ICT skills which they need to make them competitive in today's global marketplace. The Centre has 20 laptops, overhead projector, printer, white board marker and all the equipment we need.

- We also have playing materials for outside activities and (story) books / educational books.
- Coaching and mentorship sessions done by Learn! Volunteers (students!) to our young learners on areas they need further understanding in the new CBC curriculum.
- Learning trips and exposure visits related to learning areas in the curriculum.
- Counseling to learners as a group and at individual level for good mental health wellbeing
- Organising dialogue sessions with parents on good parenting and taking responsibility for their children safety and learning needs
- Ongoing Monitoring and evaluation of the program at school level for impact assessment.

Program 3: Learn! Scholars & education champions

What it is about: Supporting the dream of many needy, young people pursue high school education and college training that will make them employable and self reliant

Focus: Youth in high school, vocational training Centers (VTC), middle level colleges and universities

Ongoing activities

- Selection and home visits
- Facilitate and support them access the links and portals to fill and send their applications.
- Tuition fee support
- Shopping to go to school or college.
- Ensuring college students receive upkeep while in college.
- Provide linkages to where additional support can be received (from government, local leaders, and other well-wishers)
- Coaching and mentorship
- Counseling for good mental health wellbeing
